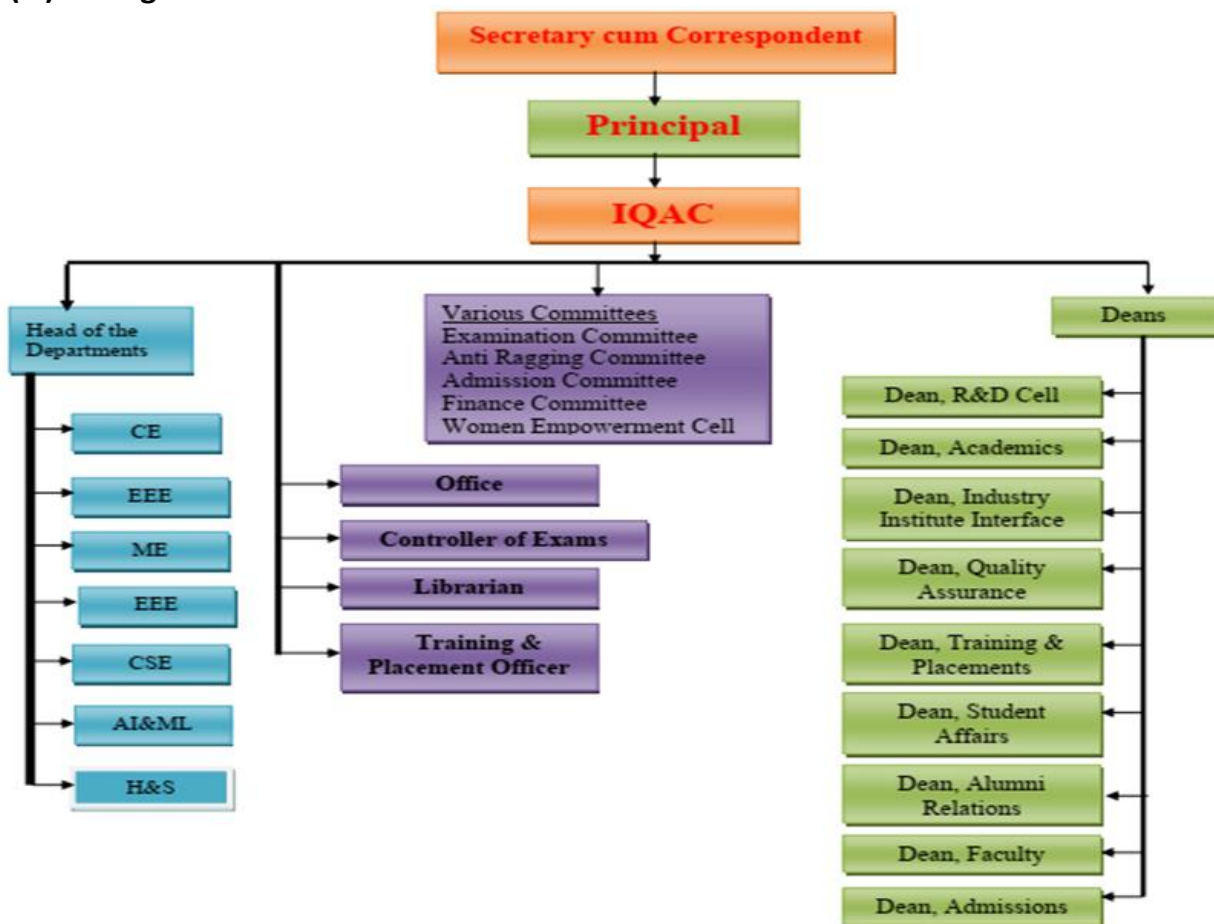

11. Admission Procedure

The entire process of admission is carried out by adopting transparent procedure, of filling up category-A & Category- B seats. Category-A seats are filled up by the convener of Admissions, EAPCET based on the ranks of the candidates, following the rule of reservation. Category-B seats are filled up by the Management of the college, following the guidelines issued by the APSCH. The admissions into the second year of B.Tech, known as lateral entry (20% of the sanctioned intake of seats) are made by the ECET convener and 10% EWS quota intake seats.

70% of the seats are allotted by the Convener, based on merit in the EAPCET (A-Category).
